Chelford Parish Council

Chelford Parish Council would like to thank all those who attended the Annual Parish Meeting on 8th May, 2025. The Rt Hon Esther McVey expressed support for the efforts being made to secure improvements to broadband services within the Parish. An interesting discussion took place regarding proposed residential developments within the Parish and their likely impact on local infrastructure and amenities. Also, concerns were voiced about the safety of pedestrians using the zebra crossing.

The Chairman gave an update on Parish Council activities during 2024/25 and also offered a vote of thanks for the great work carried out by our local volunteers including: residents leading the campaign to secure improved broadband services; the Chelford Social Committee for their successful fund raising events; the community speed watch team; the newsletter team; Chelford Edging group and all other volunteers working to support the community of Chelford. A special mention was made for Connecting Chelford on being nominated for The King's Award for Voluntary Service.

Following a few complaints, Chelford Parish Council would like to issue a polite request for all dog owners to please clear up after your pets. Many residents enjoy walking within the Parish but this can be spoiled by encountering abandoned dog poo. If you are out with your dog and realise you've forgotten your dog poo bags there are dog poo bag dispensers located at: Highland Drive (near to the Parish Council notice board); Oak Road (near to the post box); Dixon Drive (near to the no-through bollards) and Dixon Drive (near to the post box and Parish Council notice board). Let's make Chelford a dog poo free area so that everyone can enjoy (without fear of stepping in some dog poo) our beautiful surroundings.

The Parish Council has also received some complaints about vehicles speeding on Station Road. Whilst we ask all drivers to travel at sensible speeds throughout the village, please approach the station car park with care as there are many residents, including children and pets, who access this area on foot.
