Chelford Edging Group Update



Following the successful fundraising, the owl is now on its Upper Dixon Drive perch. We have a balance of £2232.00, which will be used to buy equipment, bulbs, perennials, specimen trees and shrubs. Initially we will put snowdrop and crocus bulbs on the owl site and later similarly improve other open spaces. Any donations of perennials, shrubs or trees would be appreciated.

Meanwhile, we continue to keep the verges edged and cut, gutters treated with weed killer, overhanging hedges and trees trimmed and paths clear. Particular attention has been paid to the main access road, Dixon Drive, and access to the station where footpaths and hedges have been cleared on Knutsford Road and Station Road. We have also restored the verge and footpath at the top of Oak Road.

As the local authority is increasingly cutting back on ground maintenance, particularly grass cutting, the Edging Group has been mowing the verges along Dixon Drive. It is much appreciated that many residents have also helped by mowing and caring for their adjoining verges and gutters.

We are looking for inspiration from residents on further open space maintenance and improvements around the Chelford estate. Any suggestions would be welcome. Currently the Group consists of 18 old codgers and one not old codgess. We meet for an hour on Monday and Friday mornings in the summer as convenient. Chelford Surgery

Are you up to date with your vaccinations?

- The RSV vaccine helps protect against respiratory syncytial virus (RSV), a common virus that can make babies and older adults seriously ill. It's recommended during pregnancy and for adults aged 75 to 79.
- The shingles vaccine helps protect against shingles. It's available on the NHS for all adults turning 65, those aged 70 to 79 and those aged 50 and over with a severely weakened immune system.
- Rising cases of measles have been reported in Cheshire and Merseyside. If you have not been immunised against Measles, Mumps and Rubella (the MMR vaccination) then you can have catch-up vaccinations at any age.
- The pneumococcal vaccine helps protect against serious illnesses like pneumonia and meningitis. It's recommended for people at higher risk of these illnesses, such as babies and adults aged 65 and over.

If you think you are eligible for any of these vaccinations and have not been invited for them please contact the surgery.
