## **Chelford Parish Council**

Construction of the new pathway at Chelford Activity Park has now been completed. This marks the first part of Phase 2 works which will continue shortly with the installation of gym and trim trail equipment and new surfacing around the table tennis table. If you've not already been to take a look, the new path provides a surfaced route around the site.

Thank you to everyone who has shared positive feedback about the two new speed indicator devices on Knutsford Road. This is one of several initiatives that the Parish Council is pursuing to improve safety around our local highways. Initial data from the devices has highlighted a significant number of vehicles travelling in excess of the 30mph speed limit. During September, over 4,000 vehicles were recorded by the two devices travelling in excess of 46mph.

Chelford Parish Council were saddened to hear of the recent passing of Mr. Doug Couling. Members of the Parish Council wish to record appreciation for the long standing commitment and contribution that he made to Chelford and, in particular, to Chelford Parish Hall.

### s. 106 Community Facilities Funds

The Parish Council is pleased to announce that the process to begin the allocation of remaining s.106 funds, approximately £68,500, for community facilities opened on 27th October, 2025. These contributions were made by the developer when Cricketers Green was built.

The funds will be allocated, by Cheshire East Council, to capital investment projects that improve community centres and facilities that will benefit the people within the Parish of Chelford. Community groups are encouraged to consider submitting an expression of interest form.
