## Chelford Parish Council

Chelford Parish Council would like to thank all those who attended the Annual Parish Meeting on 14th May, 2026. The Rt Hon Esther McVey congratulated Connecting Chelford on being awarded The King's Award for Voluntary Service. Useful discussions took place relating to improving infrastructure to benefit existing residents and to mitigate the impact of new development. It was noted actions appear to have started to deliver improved broadband services. Challenges associated with Cheshire East Council were also discussed and support was offered to assist efforts to create meaningful dialogue to address local issues.

The Chairman provided an update on activities during 2025/26. Progress on several issues which involve Cheshire East Council has been slow but the Parish Council is pleased to report that refurbishment work at Chelford Activity Park is now progressing. Maintenance of assets such as the bus shelter, telephone kiosk and benches has been completed and the speed indicator devices appear to be having a positive impact on the speed of traffic through the village. A number of projects are still ongoing, including village gateways, installation of gym and trim trail equipment and new picnic tables at Mere Court Park.

The Parish Council wish to thank all residents who have shared their concerns about local issues with us over the last year. We do follow up on all the issues raised, although in several cases (e.g. highway defects) we're not responsible for delivering the solution. We do, however, have opportunities to take action and we're always looking for new ideas from residents of projects we can pursue to enhance our community. The telephone kiosk at the roundabout has been repainted and we'd welcome your thoughts on how it could be used in the future.
